Code of Conduct

We want to outline a few of the team's expectations and guidelines for conduct as we get ready for the season ahead. To ensure the success of our program and the safety of everybody involved, it is each person's responsibility to hold each other accountable to meeting these standards.

BEHAVIOR

First, and foremost, each player must adhere to the rules determined by Jefferson Academy for behavior on and off the field. Failure to do so may lead to anything from missed playing time to expulsion from the team. School and district consequences may be imposed as well.

Anybody attending games or practices will show sportsmanship – this goes for players, coaches, parents, families, and fans. Whether we win or lose, we will play, coach, and cheer with class and character.

The coaches will be happy to listen to any concerns you might have. However, we will not discuss any players except your own. If there is a concern, we will be happy to listen, but we will not get into comparisons. In addition, the coaching staff prefers that any discussions about your player take place at a time that the coach sees fit -- not after practices or games. ACADEMICS

Every player must maintain passing grades in all classes. Any F grade or two D's will be ineligible. If you show up ineligible, you will be unable to play in any games for the following week. You will still be expected to practice though. Coach reserves the right to bench any player for academic or disciplinary reasons.

ATTENDANCE

Players are expected to attend two class blocks in order to practice or play in a game on that given day.

Players are expected to be at all practices and games as determined by the coaches. Any absence from a practice or game may lead to missed playing time in games. If you will need to miss a practice or game for any reason, it is your responsibility to let a coach know. Any unexcused absence from a practice may result in a missed start in the next game. Any unexcused absence from a game could result in not playing in the next game. This may also apply to excused absences where the coaching staff sees fit.
